Name of Commemorative day, holiday	Date	Day	Description of how the holiday is celebrated — a day off; to take the day off at a later date and adjustment of office hours
Memorial day in honor of Founding of the Republic of China	January 1	Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
Lunar New Year's Eve	February 7	Sunday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As it falls on Sunday, February 11 (Thursday) should be the day off to make it up.
Spring Festival	February 8 February 9 February 10 February 11 February 12	Monday Tuesday Wednesday Thursday Friday	Three days off from February 8 to 10 in accordance with established rules. February 12 (Friday) adjusts to holiday; January 30 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Peace Memorial Day	February 28	Sunday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As it falls on Sunday, February 29 (Monday) should be the day off to make it up.
Children's Day Tomb-sweeping Day	April 4 April 5	Monday Tuesday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As Children's Day and Tomb-sweeping Day falls on the same day and also on Monday, April 5 (Tuesday) should be the day off.

Labor Day	May 1 May 2	Sunday Monday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. As the Festival Holiday falls on Sunday, May 2 (Monday) should be the day off to make it up.
Dragon Boat Festival	June 9 June 10	Thursday Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. June 10 (Friday) adjusts to holiday; June 4 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
Mid-autumn Festival	September 15 September 16	Thursday Friday	One day off in accordance with the established rules. September 16 (Friday) adjusts to holiday; September 10 (Saturday) adjusts to work.
National (Double Tenth) Day	October 10	Monday	One day off in accordance with the established rules.
